The reason that God is good is that He continues to treat us with love, patience, and generosity even when we absolutely deserve anything but.

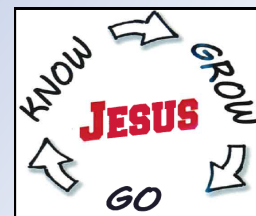
And to experience His goodness is to enjoy His sweetness, friendliness, benevolence, and generosity.

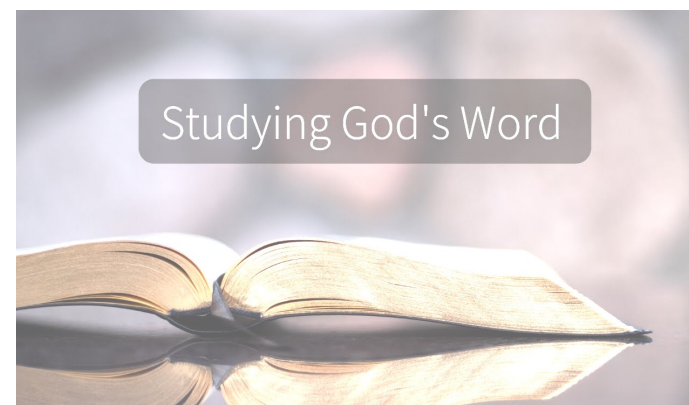
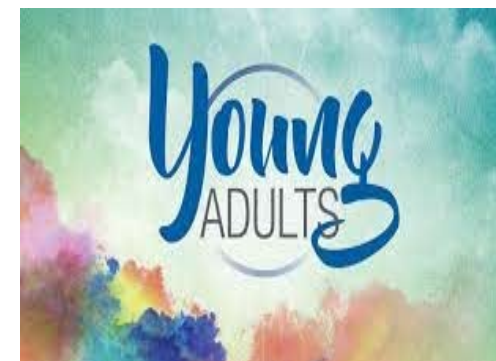

### Testimonies From the Field

#### Pakistan

In one of the villages darkness was not just present it was the identity of the people. The entire village was under the grip of witch doctors, fear and generations of spiritual bondage. The first time they entered they set up under a tree and began showing the Jesus Film. The atmosphere changed immediately some were curious but many became angry. They warned our team mLeave and never come back. But the message of Christ cannot be easily silenced. The team returned again. This time violence broke out. They were beaten so badly that their bodies carried deep scars. But even pain could not stop the mission. Days later another team of NO PLACE LEFT went back again. The villagers confronted them Why do you keep coming again and again? Don't you understand this place rejects you? Our team stood there and said calmly, First, we will show you something. Under that same tree of rejection they played the Jesus Film again. But this time something shifted in the atmosphere. When the story of Christ was preached with power silence fell. Hearts began to break. Eyes filled with tears. The demon possessed get healed and he was the one accept the Jesus Christ. In the midst of that darkness, only one man responded but he was not just a man. He became a turning point for the entire village. He received 411 training was discipled, and began to obey immediately. He mapped his Oikos network his family, relatives, friends and influence points and began sharing the Gospel boldly. One life set on fire began igniting others. From that one obedient disciple 24 people came to Jesus Christ. And now he boldly declares in the same village once ruled by fear JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH, AND THE LIFE.

#### Niger

Let us pray for our mentors who have gone to begin their work in neighboring countries like Algeria and Libya. Along the way, they have been mistreated and have suffered greatly because the journey is so difficult, but even so, they are there and preparing for their return. Please pray for their journey home and also pray that they will return to bring their families to live in these countries and serve our Lord.
